Tony Elders, Permitting and Code Enforcement Director, stated that they were proposing to add the following language to the Sediment Control Ordinance: "An initial erosion control permit site inspection is required, must be scheduled by the permit holder and approved, prior to scheduling the first building inspection."

Mr. Elders stated that the Sediment Control Appeals Board had voted unanimously in favor of adding the language.
