Shining a light on the service of veterans

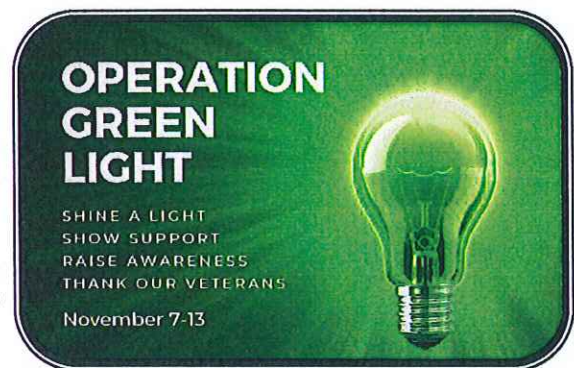
How to Participate?
