

AMENDED DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Jackson County declared a State of Emergency on September 26, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the declared State of Emergency continues to be in place; and

WHEREAS, NCGS 166A-19.31 authorizes counties to enact prohibitions and restrictions pursuant to a declared State of Emergency.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Chair of the Board of Commissioners of Jackson County under Article 1 A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and the Emergency Management Ordinance for the County of Jackson:

Section 1. The September 26, 2024, Declaration of a State of Emergency, and everything contained within it, continues to be in place in Jackson County.


Section 2. Additional prohibitions and restrictions include the following:

Pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 166A-19.31(b)(4) the sale and purchase of gasoline is restricted to 10 gallons of gas per day per person at every establishment authorized to sell gasoline within Jackson County. This restriction does not apply to emergency responders or utility repair service companies obtaining gasoline to perform work in Jackson County.

Section 3. I hereby order this amendment to the Declared State of Emergency: (a) to be distributed to news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the general public; (b) to be filed with the Clerk to the Jackson County Board of Commissioners and (c) to be posted on the County's website (d) to be sent to the Department of Public Safety's WebEOC critical incident management system (e) to be distributed to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of this declaration.

Section 4. This amended declaration shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded.
