Keeping it Together at Fairview

Regardless of how you feel about pods - Fairview does not have enough space.

- → Accessibility
 - Stairs to lunch room.. Outside non-ADA ramp for those with mobility challenges
- → Safety
 - Kitchen is not a sufficient size to be safe for staff preparing meals
- **→** Comfortable Environment
 - Lunch starts early and goes late and is still uncomfortable for students


